Improvements planned for Talunga and Murray Recreation Parks

21 February 2018

Masterplans for two Barossa recreation precincts have been released for community consultation as part of The Big Project.

The Barossa Council has unveiled masterplans for Talunga Park and Old Talunga Park at Mount Pleasant, and Murray Recreation Park at Eden Valley.

People have until 23 March to comment in writing or online.

Director Community Projects Jo Thomas said the Talunga Park and Old Talunga Park masterplan reinforces the precinct as a valued hub for recreation, events and community activities.

"A focus is improving caravan park facilities including more powered sites and a new camp kitchen, as well as linking the two parks through trails and better access," Jo said.

"The masterplan also proposes a mix of sporting and equestrian activities. We have been advised at this stage there are no plans to increase football fixtures at the oval, which provides scope to grow equestrian events and activities on-site."

Meanwhile, the masterplan for Murray Recreation Park proposes upgraded campsite and powered site facilities, nature play, improved oval irrigation and cricket access.

"The vision is to enhance the park as a space that caters for both the local community and visitors to Eden Valley," said Jo. "Its natural setting and tranquillity make it a lovely space to stop and spend some time. The plans are modest but will improve the quality of the facility."

Council invites community feedback at the upcoming Angaston and Mount Pleasant Shows, in addition to community drop-in sessions in both townships.

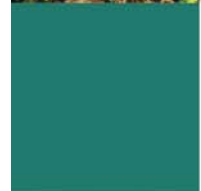
